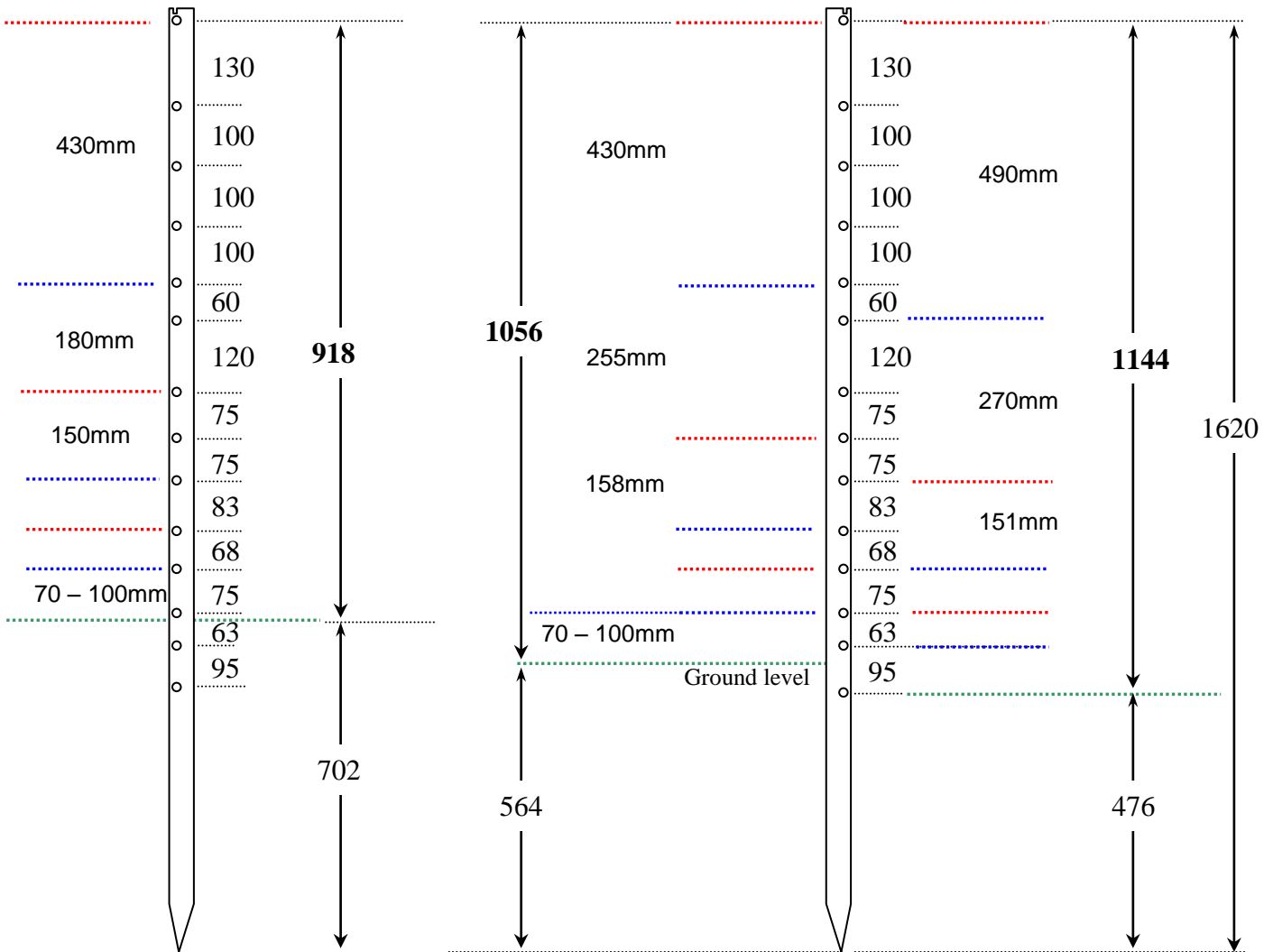


Electric Fencing Wire Spacing



This suggestion puts more wires at ground where dogs and roos will apply 99% of their pressure. Sheep are easy to contain. This spacing will be better for lambs as well. Stay with alternating earth and power. Earth on bottom. You could make the whole fence lower if you wanted. Keep the bottom wire off the ground at least 70 - 100 mm. Space posts to best fit terrain to keep bottom wire parallel to the ground. Better a bit high than too low. You can always knock a post in. Don't use droppers. Space posts around 10 m maximum. Closer in corners and near gates.
